

ORDINANCE NO. 2009 - 05

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2006-2
LEVYING CHARGES FOR THE COLLECTION AND
DISPOSAL OF MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE
WITHIN THE CITY OF CULLMAN

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULLMAN, AS
FOLLOWS:

1. Ordinance No. 2006-2, adopted by the City Council on October 24, 2005, is hereby amended as follows:

2. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 2006-2 is hereby deleted in its entirety, and a new Section 2 is hereby adopted, which reads as follows:

“SECTION 2. Beginning with the services rendered for the 1st day of January 2009, the following fees shall be charged by the City of Cullman, Alabama for the collection, transportation and disposing of municipal solid waste and inert waste:

A. RESIDENTIAL. There will be a \$13.00 per month charge, for once a week solid waste pickup, for each single family residence, town house, condominium or other living quarters within the city limits of the City of Cullman.

Provided, further, that in apartment houses or other buildings or residences where more than one family occupy and maintain separate apartments, a garbage container shall be provided by each family living in such building or residence, and each family shall pay the garbage fee required by this ordinance.

Garbage containers means a watertight receptacle of substantial construction with the capacity of at least ten (10) gallons and not more than forty-eight (48) gallons with a lid or cover and at least one handle. No garbage containers in excess of forty-eight (48) gallons or forty (40) pounds will be serviced. Garbage containers must be in good condition to prevent the possibility of injury. Garbage containers must be replaced within ten (10) days if deemed in poor condition by the City of Cullman Sanitation Department. If garbage containers are not replaced within ten (10) days, the containers will be considered trash and disposed of as waste.

B. COMMERCIAL. There will be a minimum charge of \$28.00 per month for solid waste pickup for each office or business in the City of Cullman. Seventy (\$70.00) Dollars per month shall be charged where solid waste is pickup up once a day, except for those businesses having an excess amount of solid waste and requiring more service in removal, which shall be deemed special cases. If more or less frequent service is required, fees may be adjusted accordingly.

C. CONTAINER SERVICE: Monthly container rates will be as follows:

CONTAINER SIZE	MONTHLY RATE
Two Yard Containers - once a week collection	\$ 67.00
For each additional collection per week	\$ 50.00
Four Yard Containers - once a week collection	\$ 94.00
For each additional collection per week	\$ 67.00
Six Yard Containers - once a week collection	\$ 122.00
For each additional collection per week	\$ 95.00
Eight Yard Containers - once a week collection	\$ 140.00
For each additional collection per week	\$ 105.00

Where volume justifies containerized handling which is not authorized by the customer the rate shall be \$20.00 per cubic yard.

Additional Services will be prorated.

2A. Beginning with the services rendered for the 1st day of January 2010, the following fees shall be charged by the City of Cullman, Alabama for the collection, transportation and disposing of municipal solid waste and inert waste:

A. RESIDENTIAL. There will be a \$14.00 per month charge, for once a week solid waste pickup, for each single family residence, town house, condominium or other living quarters within the city limits of the City of Cullman.

Provided, further, that in apartment houses or other buildings or residences where more than one family occupy and maintain separate apartments, a garbage container shall be provided by each family living in such building or residence, and each family shall pay the garbage fee required by this ordinance.

Garbage containers means a watertight receptacle of substantial construction with the capacity of at least ten (10) gallons and not more than forty-eight (48) gallons with a lid or cover and at least one handle. No garbage containers in excess of forty-eight (48) gallons or forty (40) pounds will be serviced. Garbage containers must be in good condition to prevent the possibility of injury. Garbage containers must be replaced within ten (10) days if deemed in poor condition by the City of Cullman Sanitation Department. If garbage containers are not replaced within ten (10) days, the containers will be considered trash and disposed of as waste.

B. COMMERCIAL. There will be a minimum charge of \$31.00 per month for solid waste pickup for each office or business in the City of Cullman. Seventy-five (\$75.00) Dollars per month shall be charged where solid waste is pickup up once a day, except for those businesses

having an excess amount of solid waste and requiring more service in removal, which shall be deemed special cases. If more or less frequent service is required, fees may be adjusted accordingly.

C. CONTAINER SERVICE: Monthly container rates will be as follows:

CONTAINER SIZE	MONTHLY RATE
Two Yard Containers - once a week collection	\$ 74.00
For each additional collection per week	\$ 57.00
Four Yard Containers - once a week collection	\$ 103.00
For each additional collection per week	\$ 76.00
Six Yard Containers - once a week collection	\$ 134.00
For each additional collection per week	\$ 107.00
Eight Yard Containers - once a week collection	\$ 153.00
For each additional collection per week	\$ 126.00

Where volume justifies containerized handling which is not authorized by the customer the rate shall be \$20.00 per cubic yard.

Additional Services will be prorated.

2B. Beginning with the services rendered for the 1st day of January 2011, the following fees shall be charged by the City of Cullman, Alabama for the collection, transportation and disposing of municipal solid waste and inert waste:

A. RESIDENTIAL. There will be a \$15.00 per month charge, for once a week solid waste pickup, for each single family residence, town house, condominium or other living quarters within the city limits of the City of Cullman.

Provided, further, that in apartment houses or other buildings or residences where more than one family occupy and maintain separate apartments, a garbage container shall be provided by each family living in such building or residence, and each family shall pay the garbage fee required by this ordinance.

Garbage containers means a watertight receptacle of substantial construction with the capacity of at least ten (10) gallons and not more than forty-eight (48) gallons with a lid or cover and at least one handle. No garbage containers in excess of forty-eight (48) gallons or forty (40) pounds will be serviced. Garbage containers must be in good condition to prevent the possibility of injury. Garbage containers must be replaced within ten (10) days if deemed in poor condition by the City of Cullman Sanitation Department. If garbage containers are not replaced within ten (10) days, the containers will be considered trash and disposed of as waste.

B. COMMERCIAL. There will be a minimum charge of \$34.00 per month for solid waste pickup for each office or business in the City of Cullman. Eighty (\$80.00) Dollars per month shall be charged where solid waste is pickup up once a day, except for those businesses having an excess amount of solid waste and requiring more service in removal, which shall be deemed special cases. If more or less frequent service is required, fees may be adjusted accordingly.

C. CONTAINER SERVICE: Monthly container rates will be as follows:

CONTAINER SIZE	MONTHLY RATE
Two Yard Containers - once a week collection	\$ 81.00
For each additional collection per week	\$ 64.00
Four Yard Containers - once a week collection	\$ 113.00
For each additional collection per week	\$ 86.00
Six Yard Containers - once a week collection	\$ 146.00
For each additional collection per week	\$ 119.00
Eight Yard Containers - once a week collection	\$ 168.00
For each additional collection per week	\$ 141.00

Where volume justifies containerized handling which is not authorized by the customer the rate shall be \$20.00 per cubic yard.

Additional Services will be prorated.

3. Section 3 of Ordinance 1191, as amended by Ordinance 2006-2, is hereby deleted in its entirety.

4. This ordinance is adopted for the purpose of changing the fees set forth in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 2006-2 for the collection, transportation and disposal of municipal solid waste and inert waste and to delete Section 3 of Ordinance 1191 previously amended by Ordinance 2006-2.


5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption, approval and publication as provided by law.
